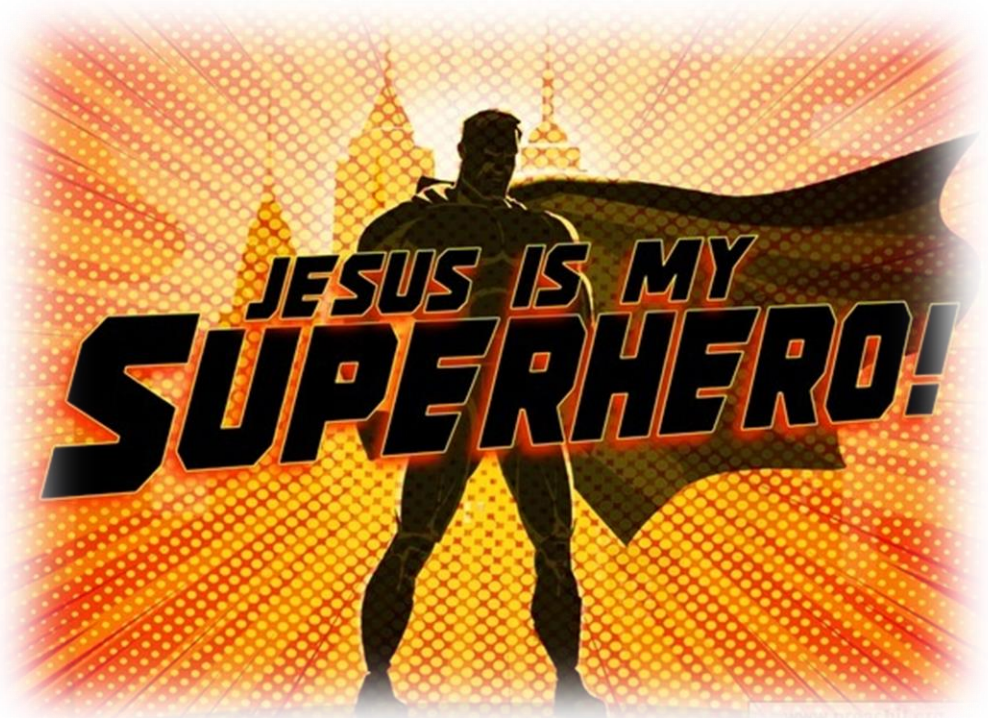

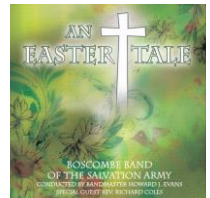
## Kids Alive! Love Party

It is understanding, redemptive goodwill for all men; theologians would say it is 'the love of God operating in the human heart' - you love everyone because God loves them. It is loving the sinner but not the sin. As Christians, may we strive to love as God loves. (IN)

**Friday 15 February** – (NSB672 'All my Work is for the Master') Generous Discipleship: Give thanks to God for His continuing care and provision for us - our time, skills, abilities and money - which in turn allows us to share the many God-given blessings with those that we come into contact with. **Saturday 16 February** – (NSB1000 'For the Healing of the Nations') Intercede for hundreds of people worldwide who have been imprisoned unjustly, often even without others knowing what has happened to them. Pray for courage, hope and deliverance as they endure this uncertainty, poor conditions, health problems and isolation. (CARE)

**Sunday 17 February** – (NSB788 'Sweet Spirit of Christ') Acts of Kindness: read Acts 9:36-42. As we are kind to those around us, those we meet... may they be prompted to turn their thoughts to God and feel valued by Him. *Dear Lord, help me to follow You and show kindness to those I meet, so they can see You in me,* (ODB)
