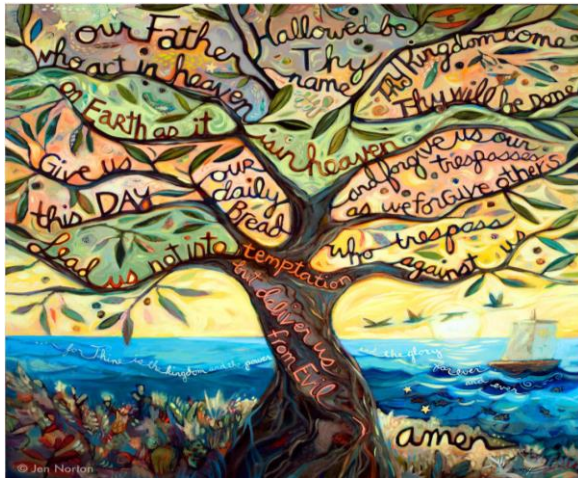

**Monday 4 March** – Joshua 1 v 9: Be strong and courageous. We are approaching Lent when we reflect on Jesus and His journey to the cross. Pray for those who face problems today. Pray for the Men's Fellowship meeting tonight. (Song 948 'Be Strong in the Grace of the Lord')

**Tuesday 5 March** – Matthew 6 v 9-13: The Lord's Prayer. Shrove Tuesday ... from the old Middle English word 'shriven' meaning to confess and say sorry for the wrong things done. An opportunity to pray for forgiveness. Also cook a Pancake! (Song 467 'How Much More')

**Wednesday 6 March** – Joel 2 V 12-14. Ash Wednesday ... the first day of Lent observed in Christianity as a day of prayer, fasting, repentance. Forty days before Easter Sunday. Pray for Ladies Fellowship meeting tonight. (Song 746 'Come ye Yourselves Apart and Rest Awhile')

**Thursday 7 March** – Philippians 3 v 10-11: Getting to know Jesus is vital. Getting to know people within the Church family is important. Contact someone today and share your faith. Pray for the Adult and Family ministries Rally at Boscombe today and for the Open Band rehearsal this evening. Please also focus on the 24-3 prayer event starting tonight at 10pm until 9am on Sunday. Join in or at least commune daily for those at prayer. (Song 200 'Tell out the Wonderful Story')

**Friday 8 March** – 1 Peter 5 v 6. Our Lenten journey gives opportunity to humble ourselves before God. Today marks the anniversary of Reverend Geoffrey Studdart Kennedy's death. This unsung hero of World War 1, better known as 'Woodbine Willie', humbly worked for justice on behalf of the poor. Pray for our BH1 and Meal Run teams as they serve the unfortunate today.
