Second week in Lent

Monday 11 March – Luke 6 v 36-38. Three important points of guidance in the Christian life. 1 Try to initiate the Father in all things. 2 Do not be critical of others in matters where we expect our own failures. 3 We must show compassion. Pray for Christians at work as they try to uphold Christian standards. (Song 562 'Yes the Lord is my Shepherd, I have all that I need')

Tuesday 12 March –Matthew 23 v 1-5 and 11-12. Practice what you preach is the essence of our reading today. It is vital that we are viewed as true Christians in all aspects of our living. Pray for young Christians in our Universities and Colleges. (Song 956 'He who would valiant be')

Wednesday 13 March – Matthew 20 v 17-28. Take time to digest these verses. Ambition ... some people will do anything to achieve ... power can corrupt. May the Lord help us to be humble in spirit and action. Pray for retired Officers meeting in their fellowship today at Boscombe. (Song 790 'Take time to be holy')

Thursday 14 March – Jeremiah 17 v 9-10. From Jeremiah we receive the assurance nothing escapes the knowledge of God. He searches our hearts. He knows us and what we are and what we do. Pray for your neighbours today. Let them know you prayed for them. (Song 290 'Spirit of God, descend upon my heart')

Friday 15 March – Matthew 21 v 33-43 and 45-46. Jesus teaches in parables to emphasise important truths. Honesty in business. Unfortunately, even within the Church people have been proved to be dishonest. We must cleanse ourselves during this Lenten journey. Pray for the business community. Pray that all working within the financial sector will be honest and true. (Song 294 'Breathe on me, breath of God')

Saturday 16 March –Micah 7 v 18-20. God pardons our sins and forgives. We have reflected this week on what it means to present the face of Christ to the world. Let us be bold in declaring our faith. Pray for families today ... hopefully enjoying love and life together. (Song 366 'Hosanna in the highest')

Sunday 17 March – Exodus 22 v 20-23. As we begin the third week of lent, we often begin to tire in keeping our Lenten promises. Our commitment declines. Pray the Lord will keep us close to Him and maintain our faithfulness. Pray for our worship meeting this morning. (Song 376 'King of kings, majesty')
