

PRAYER MATTERS

Monday 15 April – (NSB165) '<u>Do as I have done</u>' John13:1-15. No one is more important than anyone else. Are we prepared to be the least important person, or do we always want to be greatest? Jesus shows us how to treat one another, with love and respect. Pray for all who feel they have no voice or standing in society; pray that those with power and authority would use it to bring justice and peace. (Roots)

Tuesday 16 April – (NSB610) 'Remember Me' Luke 22:14-20. Pray for those who are unaware of the Love of God for them; those who have sad memories and want to forget. Pray that the powerful message of the film 'The Shack' will bring a positive challenge to everyone watching. (You can also download the book to your Kindle!)

Wednesday 17 April – (NSB599) Jesus challenges the disciples to 'Get up and Pray'. Luke 22:39-46. Can you sense the emotions in this reading? Can you pray in times of distress? Pray for others who are distressed or frightened; who are lonely and who have lost hope; those who are trying to pray but find it difficult. (Roots)

Thursday 18 April – (NSB715) 'I do not know Him'. Jesus' disciples deny knowing Him. Luke 22:54-62. Why did Peter lie? How did he feel when Jesus looked at him? What would we have done... and felt?? Pray for all who are persecuted or bullied for what they believe; pray they may have courage to witness to their faith. Give thanks that, like Peter, when we too make mistakes, Jesus will forgive, restore and use us to 'fulfil His intentions' for our life. (Roots) **Friday 19 April** – **Good Friday -** (NSB769) 'Jesus carries His Cross to Calvary'.

Luke 23:26-27. This is yours and my Lord they are taking away. Imagine you are among the crowd, watching Jesus. Pray for those who are sad and mourn; for those who are unjustly accused; for those who are cruel and hurt others. Thank God for the power of Jesus' death and resurrection. (Roots)

Saturday 20 April – (NSB600) Give thanks for every person who is called to be an evangelist. Pray that their faith and sense of calling will be deepened. Ask God to encourage anyone who is finding it a challenging experience just now. (CARE)

Sunday 21 April – **Easter Sunday -** (NSB204) 'I have seen the Lord'. The women discover the tomb is empty. He is Risen! John 20:11-18. Mary is outside the tomb, weeping. The angels ask 'why?', and Mary says 'Tell me where He is'. Jesus simply calls her by her name, and then says to her **'Go and tell.'** and she's away.... I have seen the Lord! If we had been with Mary in the garden, what would you or I have done? Pray today for everyone, including each one of us who has the **wonderful news to tell of our risen Saviour, Jesus.**' (Roots)
