## PRAYER MATTERS

**Monday 22 April** – (NSB12 'Eternal God') This time of year there's lots of talk about chocolate eggs and Easter bunnies!! but the Bible makes it very clear that Easter is all about Jesus. Have any of our friends missed Easter's *real* meaning? How can we help them understand the purpose of Jesus' death and resurrection? Bring them by name before the Lord in prayer, asking for His help and guidance for each one. (ODB)

**Tuesday 23 April** – (NSB300 'Gracious Spirit') Luke 24:13-35. 'The road to Emmaus'. The two followers of Jesus, with heavy hearts and bitter disappointment; all their ultimate hopes dashed by His death. When Jesus came alongside them, they could clearly recount all the events to Him. Yet, were blind to their real meaning... in possession of all the facts but had no faith. As Jesus explained everything to them... suddenly, their eyes were opened, and they recognised Him...and rushed straight back to tell the disciples. He had 'fired' their hearts to life. When the Bible is taught, then God opens blind eyes to see the glory of His risen Son. Pray for those who need to hear God's Word, whose minds are closed by unbelief. How has Jesus opened your 'spiritual eyes'? (ODB)

**Wednesday 24 April** – (NSB932 'The Lord's Command') Pray for organisations dedicated to making Scripture available and accessible to as many people as possible, particularly in countries that are closed to the Gospel. Amen. (CARE)

**Thursday 25 April** – (NSB164 '...From a Secret Armoury') Psalm 63:2. In David's day, the Sanctuary was in Jerusalem. Today **we** are the sanctuary, with God's glory living in us (Romans 8:11) *Lord prepare me to be a sanctuary, pure and holy, tried and true. With thanksgiving, I'll be a living sanctuary for you (words of a song by Randy Scruggs). Amen (THQ)*

**Friday 26 April** – (NSB616 'O Love') Remember today the family of Don Whitlock (who was for many years a proficient euphonium player in Boscombe Band, and who very much enjoyed his banding). Think especially just now of Joy and Siri and Alastair, and all who will gather for his funeral this afternoon. Pray for Lt Colonel William Main as he leads the service.

**Saturday 27 April** – (NSB723 'Loved with Everlasting Love') *Lord, You wait in the corners of my consciousness, with exquisite courtesy, endless patience and loving kindness - and I love You! (EA)*

**Sunday 28 April** – (NSB1003 'O Lord, whose Human Hands') My Father God, I want my worship of You to extend beyond the walls of my church. Help me to listen to Your prompting and to serve others wherever I can - no matter what day it is. (ODB)
