Monday 6 May – James 1 v 17. Every day now we enjoy more light. God's light lights our path. On this day in 1994 the Channel Tunnel opened. The longest undersea tunnel in the world. Let us pray for better communication with nations. Pray for God's light to shine in all the earth. (Song 322 'Lord, give me more soul-saving love')

Tuesday 7 May – Psalm 145 v 5. On this day in 1893 Edward Munch painted 'The Scream' highlighting the problem of anxiety and worry. Pray for people suffering with these problems. Let us follow the Psalmist and meditate on God's wonderful works. (Song 36 'I sing the mighty power of God')



Wednesday 8 May – Isaiah 26 v 3. This is V.E.Day. The Second World War ended on this day in 1945. Let us give thanks for peace. Pray for continued peace within our world. Meditate on these great words of Isaiah. (Song 1010 'Peace in our time, O Lord')

On a personal note pray for spiritual renewal in keeping with our reading today. (Song 601 'Lord, I come to You')

Saturday 11 May – Psalm 40 v 3. On this day in 1820 in Woolwich HMS Beagle was launched and Charles Darwin discovered His theory of natural selection. Let us thank God for people who have made our world better by their personal adventures of discovery. The Psalmist wants us to sing His praises today. (Song 370 'I want to sing it, I want to shout it')
