PRAYER MATTERS

Monday 13 May – Philippians 4 v13. *Achieving*. It is important to set personal goals. Spiritually speaking. Why don't you do this today if you have not done so already. The reading today should inspire you. It is the Men's Fellowship tonight. Pray for the male members of our Corps, especially those in hospital or unwell at home. (Song 857 'I'm going to make my life a melody')

Tuesday 14 May – Deuteronomy 31 v 6-8. *Courage*. We all need courage to face the challenges that come before us daily. The challenge of changed circumstances. The challenge of financial burdens. The challenge of family decisions. Our reading assures us of the Lord's presence. Pray for your family today, each member in turn. (Song 488 'Courage, brother, do not stumble')

Wednesday 15 May – Isaiah 40 v 31. *Hope*. What do you expect today? What do you wish for today? What is your hope for today? Synonyms for hope include ambition, dream, desire, aspiration. Our reading advises us to hope in the Lord and the results are amazing. Pray for young people today searching for hope. Students at University, children at school, those youngsters in employment as well as those unfortunately unemployed. (Song 893 'Since the Lord redeemed us from the power of sin')

Thursday 16 May – 1 Corinthians 10 v 13. *Temptation*. Temptation faces us all at various stages. Sometimes simply to eat the wrong diet. To avoid speaking the truth. To shy away from making important decisions. Let the reading today guide you. Pray for the ladies in our Corps. It is Home League day. Some ladies you know may need our special thoughts and prayers. (Song 994 'Yield not to temptation, for yielding is sin')

Friday 17 May – Matthew 11 v 28. *Weariness*. Five burdens we need not carry. *Worry - Failure - Injustice - Sin - Guilt*. Jesus through His life, death and Resurrection has lifted our burdens. Pray for people suffering with anxiety who have seemingly immovable burdens. Pray for the homeless and those suffering with addictions. (Song 197 'I know a found where sins are washed away')

Saturday 18 May – 2 Corinthians 12 v 9. *Grace*. It is wonderful when we encounter people who display a gracious spirit and attitude. Kind people, forgiving people, controlled people, loving people. Are we people of grace? Pray that God will use you today as a result of your natural and spiritual influence wielded in your actions and behaviour. (Song 699 'Every promise we can make')

Sunday 19 May – 2 Thessalonians 3 v 3. *Faithfulness*. How reliable are we in all aspects of our living? Faithfulness - what a quality to possess. We see unfaithfulness everywhere ... failed marriages, strained relationships, broken promises in business life. Broken vows within the church. Our scripture reading highlights the faithfulness of God. Pray for people making new vows today. (Song 360 'Faithful God, faithful God')
