PRAYER MATTERS

Monday 10 June – (NSB647 'I must have the Saviour') Father God, as we focus our minds on You, so we would open our hearts before You, and listen to Your Spirit's prompting of names of people who need Christ. Pledge to pray for these people every day, especially praying: *'Thy Kingdom come, O Lord, in the heart of.....'* (THQ)

Tuesday 11 June – (NSB667 'O Master, let me walk') Paul, writing to the Galatians (6:2) says *'Let's pray for others - even people we don't know.
