This week we will look at Matthew 5 vv1-12 - The Beatitudes.

Monday 2 September – *Blessed are those that mourn.* Many people are grieving today. Jesus offers comfort for all. Pray for people you know who may have lost family members recently. (Song 30 'He giveth more grace as our burdens grow greater')

Tuesday 3 September – *Blessed are the meek.* Not the weak, but those who experience humility. Pray as humble people, seeking to embrace this divine quality in our everyday living. (Song 502 'Jesus, tender lover of my soul')

Wednesday 4 September – *Blessed are those who hunger and thirst after righteousness.* How urgent are we to be better people? Pray for new enthusiasm to really grow spiritually. Let us urgently pray for spiritual progress within our Corps and all Churches. (Song 497 'I want, dear Lord, a heart that's true and clean')

Thursday 5 September – *Blessed are the merciful.* How important it is to forgive! So many homes are in chaos because family or friends will not forgive. Pray that forgiveness will heal many disputes today. (Song 467 'If human hearts are often tender')

Friday 6 September – *Blessed are the pure in heart.* We desire to live in a clean and beautiful world. Pray that people will try to be clean in every aspect of the word. Pray that we may all seek to achieve personal integrity in all things. Pray for the continuation of Holiness teaching within our worship meetings. (Song 311 'Spirit divine, come as of old')

Saturday 7 September – *Blessed are the peacemakers.* Peace brings joy and with it future hope. It opens up doors of opportunity and development. Pray for world peace and those engaged in peace-making discussions. Pray for our own country at present as we face an uncertain future. (Song 1010 'Peace in our time, O Lord') Pray for the Big collection effort in our town centre today as our musical sections witness and collect much needed funds for the work of the Army.

Sunday 8 September – A special verse for today ... Psalm 107 'Give thanks to the Lord, for He is good. His love endures forever'. Let us thank Him for the simple blessings we receive daily. I wish more people would come to our meeting on a Sunday morning on a regular basis. Why not invite someone yourself to join our fellowship.
