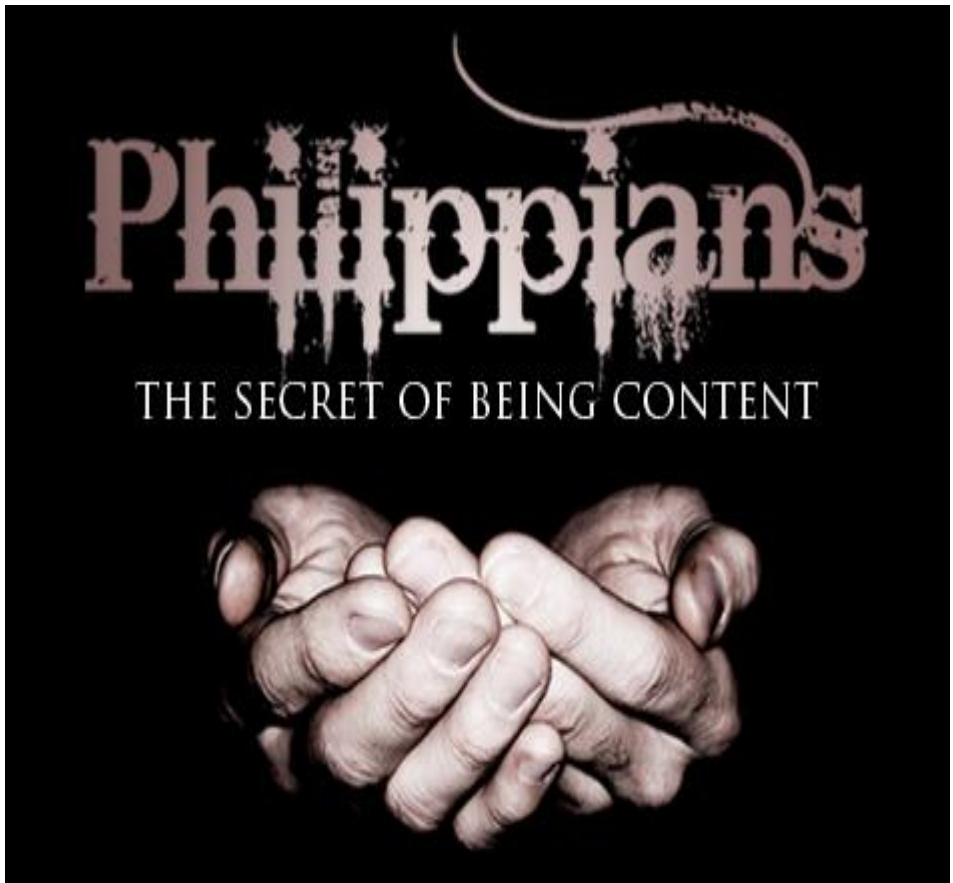

Monday 9 September – Psalm 121 v 1-2. Where do we get our help from? Read this quote from St Augustine ... 'What does love look like? It has the hands to help others, it has the feet to hasten to the poor and needy. It has the eyes to see many in misery and want. It has the ears to hear the sighs and sorrowing of men. That is what love looks like'. Pray for Home Care workers today and our Corps Leadership team meeting tonight. (Song 946 'A charge to keep I have')

Tuesday 10 September – Romans 1 v 11-12. Spiritual gifts. Quote from Charles Haddon Spurgeon ... 'God never loses sight of the treasure which He has placed in our earthly vessels'. Pray for those working in the education of our young people. (Song 60 'Thank you, God, for your gift beyond words')

Wednesday 11 September – Acts 16 v 25. Witnessing for the Lord. Quote from Leonard Street/ Frank Viola ... 'The strength of the Church is not the strength of its institutions but the authority of its witness'. Pray for the editors of Christian publications. (Song 930 'Tell them in the east and in the west')

Thursday 12 September – Psalm 73 v 26. God is our strength. 'At my lowest God is my help. At my darkest God is my light. At my weakest God is my strength. At my saddest God is my comfort'. (Anon) Pray for people who are suffering with incurable diseases. (Song 391 'Stand up and bless the Lord')

Friday 13 September – Jeremiah 29 v 13. Seeking after God. I read this recently ... 'If we are diligent in seeking God then slowly and surely we become better people'. Pray for your neighbours today. (Song 675 'Seek ye first the Kingdom of God')

Saturday 14 September – 1 John 1 v 6. Be honest with God. 'Honesty is the first chapter of the book of wisdom', so says Thomas Jefferson. Pray for all people working within our social services. (Song 666 'O for a humbler walk with God!')

Sunday 15 September – Proverbs 15 v 23. A word in season. Mother Teresa said, 'Love is a fruit in season at all times and within reach of every hand'. Pray for the ministry of the Adult and Family Ministry groups within our Corps today. (Song 344 'Sing to God new songs of worship')
