

PRAYER MATTERS

Monday 10 January – (NSB712) ‘A Christian community is made of people who gather around the transforming presence of Christ so they can do the will of God’. (Ruth Haley Barton) (THQ) Loving Lord, draw us ever closer to You as the days and weeks of this new year unfold. You are our strength, the Rock that we stand on, Lord.

Tuesday 11 January – (NSB1010) Let’s reach outside our Corps Family in prayer this week and draw into our thoughts and fellowship people in troubled areas of our World. *Dear Father, we cry out for peace and stability for these people. We especially pray for the children and their families in northern Ethiopia, and also the children and families living in Haiti who are suffering from disasters... natural and manmade. Please comfort them with Your Love, goodness and strength. Lord, You are the Great Healer, and we ask just now that You bring calm into the Lebanon, to the parties in conflict there, and bring comfort to families and restore their livelihoods. Lord Jesus, we long for there to be peace. Amen. (IN)*

Wednesday 12 January – (NSB335) ‘Jesus went up on a mountainside and called to Him those He wanted, and they came to Him’ (Mark 3:14). To gather around the transforming presence of Jesus involves His call and our choice. Pray to hear and respond. (THQ)

Thursday 13 January – (NSB1008) Dear Lord, please bring hope to children and families who have lost everything to conflict in Syria. May they find peace in You and courage to rebuild their lives and country. Amen. We also focus on South Sudan, where there has been constant serious armed conflict and natural disasters, impacting its people for 10 years. In 2021 about 8.3 million people needed humanitarian aid (UN), and flooding has forced an estimated 780,000 people to flee communities along the Nile and Lol rivers, and in the Sudd marshlands since May. *‘Prince of Peace, we pray for the restoration of peace and civility in South Sudan, so that children can grow into all You intend them to be. Amen.’*

Friday 14 January – (NSB1003) Lord, help me to understand that to ‘love my neighbour’ doesn’t just mean someone close by, but means **anyone who has a need**; that **‘what happens to any of us, anywhere in the world, had better be the business of us all’**. (ODB)

Saturday 15 January – (NSB998) Being together in God’s covenant will include being with people from whom we might think very differently on all kinds of issues. Let us pray for unity in our diversity and the wisdom to learn to disagree well! (THQ)

Sunday 16 January – (NSB338) Major Joy Webb has composed so many beautiful words and melodies, including these: *‘Love is a place where you are always welcome, Love is an open hand stretched out to care; Love is of God, and where His Name is honoured... Love is there.’* As we embrace a new season let us reaffirm our desire to love God and love others. (THQ)
