

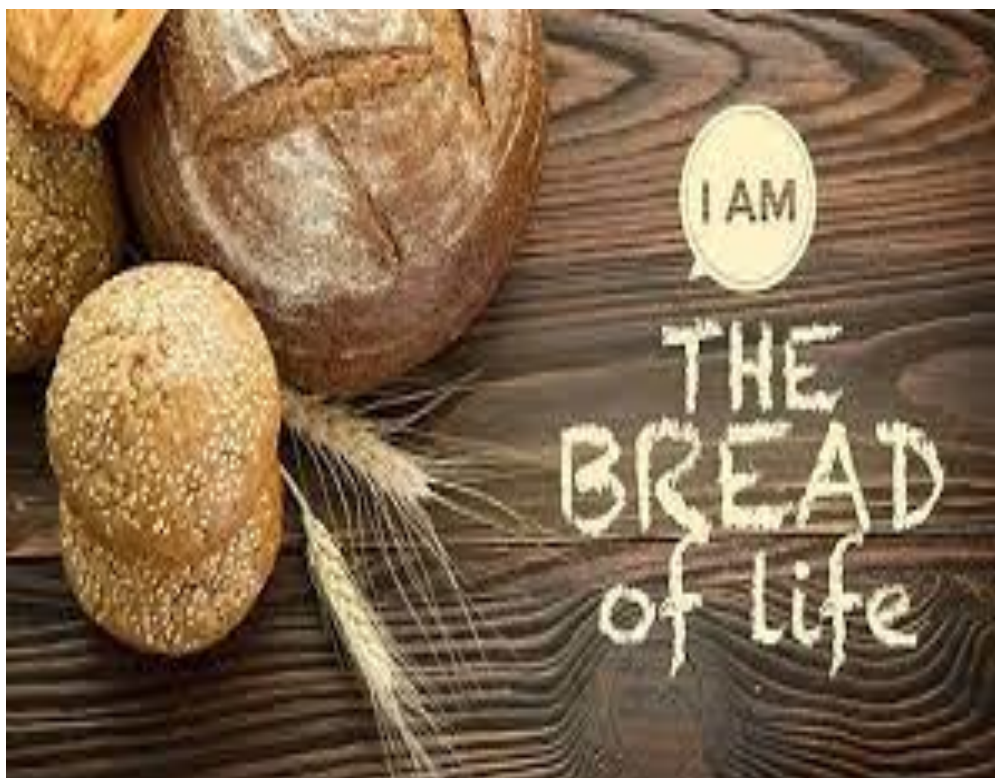

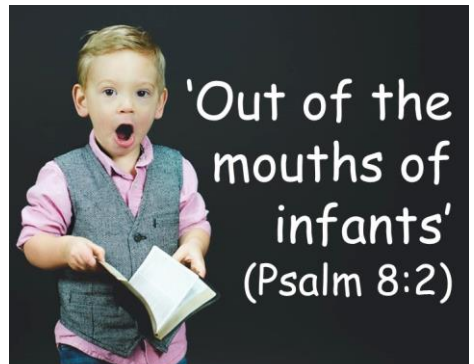
Friday 29 July – *Loving Father we lift before you all who are hungry today and whose children and babies are too weak to cry for food.*
