

PRAYER MATTERS

Monday 1 August – Quote by Susan Coles Schultz: ‘Let us dance in the sun, wearing wild flowers in our hair’. Do something enjoyable - get outside if you can. Dance in the Spirit of the Lord. Read Psalm 150 v 4: ‘Praise Him with the timbrel and dance. Praise Him with the strings and pipe’. Pray for Christian Holiday Camps and Schools being held. (Song 56 ‘Praise to the Lord, the Almighty, the King of creation’)

Tuesday 2 August – Quote by Morgan Freeman: ‘Learning how to be still, to really be still and let life happen, that stillness becomes a radiance’. Take the opportunity of a quiet moment to think of someone in need. Read Psalm 37 v 7: ‘Be still before the Lord and wait patiently for Him’. (Song 353 ‘Be still, for the presence of the Lord’)

Wednesday 3 August – Quote by Jim Rohn: ‘Happiness is not something you postpone for the future, it is something you design for the present’. Read Romans 15 v 13: ‘Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy’. Pray for people finding it difficult to be happy for some unknown reason. (Song 835 ‘Happiness is to know the Saviour’)

Thursday 4 August – Quote by Sara Baume: ‘This morning, the sun endures past dawn. I realise that it is August’. Read Amos 8 v 1: ‘This is what the Lord God showed me: behold a basket of summer fruits’. Pray and thank God for those responsible for growing and harvesting our food. (Song 59 ‘Summer suns are glowing over land and sea’)

Friday 5 August – Quote by Michael Stillwell: ‘The tan will fade but the memories will last forever’. One of the greatest gifts that God has given humanity is the beautiful gift of memory. In a sense, memory allows us to relive a moment that was special to us. Read Luke 2 v 19: ‘Mary treasured up all these things, pondering them in her heart’. Pray for the people you know who suffer with Dementia. (Song 895 ‘The Saviour sought and found me’)

Saturday 6 August – Quote by Lilly Pulitzer: ‘It’s always Summer somewhere’. Read Genesis 1 v 3: ‘And God said ‘Let there be light and there was light’. Pray for families today enjoying their time together, wherever they are. (Song 834 ‘God is our light and God is our sunshine’)

Sunday 7 August – Quote by an Unknown Author: ‘August is like the Sunday of Summer’. So many thoughts and emotions about Sunday. For me it is the Lord’s Day and important that I go to the Army, my church and worship. Read Psalm 118 v 24: ‘This is the day that the Lord has made, let us rejoice and be glad in it’. My prayer is that many more will do likewise. (Song 52 ‘O worship the King, all glorious above’)
